Cherry Haisten is Lay Pastor, Taizé at St. Andrew's, and Contemplative Ministries Coordinator, The Center at St. Andrew's. She has practiced Centering Prayer since she learned it from Fr. Thomas Keating in May 1990. Commissioned by Contemplative Outreach and long active in leadership of Contemplative Outreach Northwest, she leads workshops and retreats on the Welcoming Prayer, and other contemplative topics around the United States and in British Columbia.

Gordon Coffey was taught Centering Prayer by Fr. Thomas Keating during Fr. Thomas's visits to Seattle in 1986 and attended the September 1987 intensive retreat by Fr. Thomas that led to the creation of Contemplative Outreach Northwest. Gordon's practice of Centering Prayer drew him to become a presenter of introductory workshops as well as the Contemplative Outreach program for people in 12-step recovery.
